The IEEE Project 802 plenary for developing LAN/MAN standards was held July 8-12 in Vancouver BC. Attendance was approximately 1000 people from approximately 400 companies.

802.0 Executive Committee:

- * The LMSC co-located their meeting with the IEEE-Standards Association Board of Governors for the first time. The meeting gave the LMSC and BoG members a chance to interact and better understand how each group functions.
- * The composition of the executive committee changed slightly as a result establishment of a voting position for the 2nd vice chair, a new Technical Advisory Group on Coexistence and a new Executive Committee Study Group on Mobile Broadband Wireless Access. See figure one for an organization chart.

- Mat Sherman appointed to 2nd vice chair voting position.

- Coexistence Technical Advisory Group, Jim Lansford Interim Chair.

- Mobile Broadband Wireless Access Executive Committee Study Group, Mark Klerer Chair.

New Groups and Tutorials:

802.18 Radio Regulatory Technical Advisory Group: * Carl Stevenson, Chair

- * First Plenary Session. Carl Stevenson affirmed as chair. Chartered to act as 802 regulatory expert and interface to regulatory bodies.

802.19 Coexistence Technical Advisory Group: * Jim Lansford, Interim Chair

- * newly formed. Chartered to develop IEEE 802 on process and procedure to establish coexistence policy.

Mobile Broadband Wireless Access Executive Committee Study Group: * Mark Klerer, Chair

- * newly formed. Chartered to determine if there is enough industry interest in this area to warrant the initiation of a formal 802 project by November 2002. The recommendation may result in the formation of new Working Group or be done within an existing Working Group.

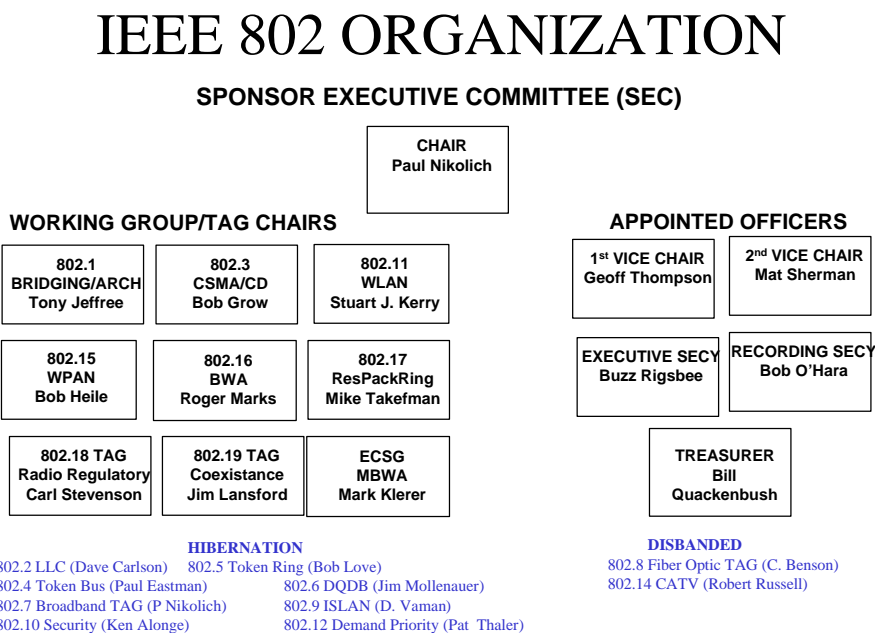


Figure 1. IEEE 802 Organization

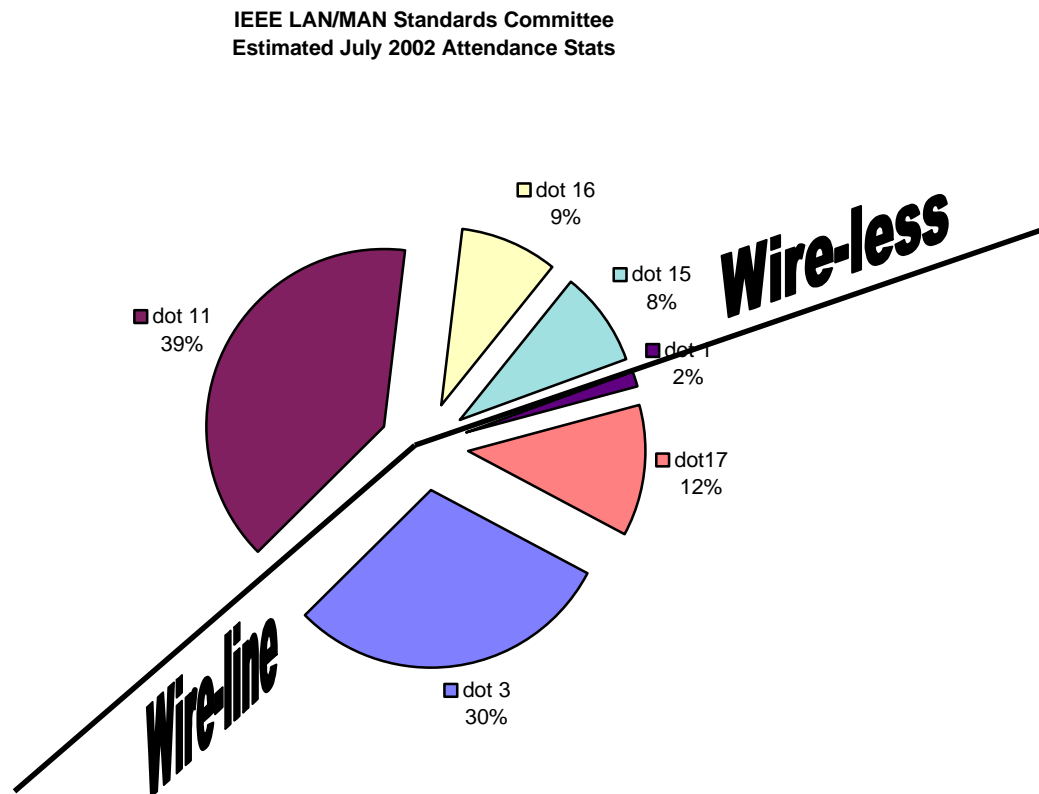


Figure 2 Attendance on a per Group basis

The IEEE 802 organization is shown below in figure 1. The various working groups, technical advisory groups (TAG), study groups and executive positions are shown. The boxes with dotted lines are groups that have been 'hibernated' meaning their work has been completed or 'disbanded' meaning their work was never published. Figure 2 illustrates the relative sizes of each of the active groups within IEEE 802 based on attendance data from November 2002.
