

# IEEE P802.3.1 (IEEE 802.3.1a) Ethernet MIBs (Revision) Procedure for Conditional Approval to Forward a Draft Standard

The following is the Clause 12 'Procedure for Conditional Approval to Forward a Draft Standard' report for IEEE P802.3.1 (IEEE 802.3.1a) Ethernet MIBs (Revision) which received conditional approval to proceed to Sponsor ballot at the March 2013 IEEE 802 Plenary meeting.

*a) Recirculation ballot is completed. Generally, the recirculation ballot and resolution should occur in accordance with the schedule presented at the time of conditional approval.*

The schedule presented to March 2013 closing IEEE 802 EC meeting when requesting conditional approval was:

8th April 2013	2nd Recirculation Ballot Opens
22nd April 2013	2nd Recirculation Ballot Closes
13th May 2013	Interim meeting date if required

BALLOT OPEN: Monday, 15<sup>th</sup> April 2013  
BALLOT CLOSE: Tuesday, 30<sup>th</sup> April 2013 11:59 p.m. EDT

**The recirculation occurred essentially in accordance with the plan presented.**

*b) After resolution of the recirculation ballot is completed, the approval percentage is at least 75% and there are no new valid DISAPPROVE votes.*

The ballot results after resolution are:

**The approval rate after resolution of the ballot is greater than 75% and there were no new negative DISAPPROVES votes.**

*c) No technical changes, as determined by the WG Chair, were made as a result of the recirculation ballot.*

**No technical changes have been made.**

*d) No new valid DISAPPROVE comments on new issues that are not resolved to the satisfaction of the submitter from existing DISAPPROVE voters.*

**There were no new valid DISAPPROVE comments.**

**Two editorial required (ER) comment, not associated with a vote, were received from Editorial Coordination. The first reads 'The changes presented in this draft meet all editorial requirements once the revised PAR is approved.', the second reads 'After a second review, I remove my conditions about the PAR. This draft meets all editorial requirements'. As a point of information there isn't a revised PAR associated with this project.**

*e) If the WG Chair determines that there is a new invalid DISAPPROVE comment or vote, the WG Chair shall promptly provide details to the Sponsor.*

**There were no new invalid DISAPPROVE comments.**

*f) The WG Chair shall immediately report the results of the ballot to the Sponsor including: the date the ballot closed, vote tally and comments associated with any remaining disapproves (valid and invalid), the WG responses and the rationale for ruling any vote invalid.*
